The next County Commissioner meeting is scheduled for April 24, when the overnight parking issue will be brought up. The operators would need three acres.

Lisa Ruckman gave an update on the Indian River Lagoon and related issues.

A signup sheet of volunteers was passed around to members. We are planning for some 50 or so members. There will be no charge for members, \$3 per guest or \$5 per guest family. Discussion ensued on Merritt Island having to incorporate to control its destiny.
