

KEEP OUR WATER CLEAN

The Annual Coastal Cleanup this year is Saturday, Sept 16. "Water has a cyclical nature, which means that anything we are putting into our oceans & other water bodies will come back to us sooner or later & minute plastic particles are already showing up in our food & water." At the height of hurricane season it's ONLY RAIN DOWN THE STORM DRAIN and on the streets. It costs our Lagoon and costs us dollars when plant cuttings are placed too close to the street or on top of storm drains. Place cut pieces in the designated bin for weekly pickup or chop them smaller for mulch under plants or place the parts in your compost pile/bin.

EMIHOA 2022-2023 **Year in Review**

Last September we discussed concerns about the garbage that is left around the SR 528 causeway & recreation happening on the shoulder of the highway. So far we have had no response from legislators or other state officials.

Detailed information about the neighborhood Septic to Sewer projects was given in the Brevard County Save Our Indian River Lagoon presentation. In April our District 2 Commissioner spoke to us at our meeting and promised to look into the condition of the bridges on N Banana River Dr. His office got back to us with the schedule of the estimated bridge study completions (Dec 2023). Repair work over the bridges has since occurred over the summer months!
